Terry Welshans reported that there are 37 active members and that the bank account is unchanged from January. One membership was paid by check at the meeting and that will be deposited tomorrow.

Randy spoke about House Bill 447, a bill to remove the personal property tax on non-commercial aircraft. The AOPA contacted him saying they will lobby to support this bill.

Curtis Hall spoke about the airport breakfast saying that he has brought some breakfast burritos to try out and they are in the airport refrigerator. Comments are welcome. He added that these are an addition to our regular menu items.

Terry was asked to buy three more chaffing dish sets and a supply of fuel.

Randy spoke about fly-outs for this spring, suggesting Rough River airport. Several other locations were brought up and all have good breakfast and lunch offerings.

Randy presented a safety video concerning landing in a valley at night. The video emphasizes that it is necessary to do a complete review of the airport and the approach as the video demonstrated a close call as the approach was too low and nearly hit a ridge that was not visible at night.
