Meeting Minutes – Oct. 13, 2022

Randy White opened the regularly scheduled Kentucky Pilots Association meeting at 7:00 PM.

Terry Welshans said that the KPA bank account is at \$4005.47 after depositing \$1559.36 from the Saturday breakfast. Membership stands at 28 with one youth member. He reported that 5 members who are more than 3 months late with their dues will be dropped this month.

Tom Vernon reported that the elevator in the terminal building is being installed and that the QT Pod is still having problems. He said that the upstairs classrooms are finished and can be used after the elevator is inspected some time in November.
