Meeting Minutes – April. 13, 2023

Randy White called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Randy spoke about the continuing problems with the QT Pod fueling equipment. Almost every part of the unit has been replaced and the problems continue.

Terry Welshans said the number of members is unchanged at 36. A number of members are overdue with their dues and will send an email to those members. He said that the most recent bank statement shows \$2937.24, but that does not include the \$800 in expenses for the Saturday breakfast or the \$870 deposit or the \$70 (less expense) Square deposit as they are after the date the statement was made.

There was a general discussion about how to improve the breakfast. Most of the discussion was about the cleanup of the grills. It was suggested that we find a better way of making scrambled eggs as that cleanup between batches and switching to pancakes on the same grill was lots of work. We will try doing the eggs in a plastic bag as we get them in hot water. This eliminates doing them on the grill and allows faster pancake production. Randy said he will buy a table-top induction heater that will do the job.

Randy had two safety videos. The first one was on wake turbulence behind helicopters and featured a Cessna 120 landing behind a helicopter. The Cessna's right wing stalled and the Cessna crashed from a low altitude. The second video was about carbon monoxide poisoning caused by a leaking muffler. The pilot had taken off, became unconscious and the aircraft landed itself in a field after the fuel was exhausted. Both pilots survived.
